**ATM Services to be Available at “VIEW ALTTE” ATM Corners of
 East Japan Railway Company Stations**

Tokyo (Tuesday, October 15, 2013) --- Shinsei Bank, Limited (“Shinsei Bank”) today announced that it has entered into a partnership with Viewcard Co., Ltd. (Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo, President and CEO: Atsuhiko Kano) (hereafter “Viewcard”), a wholly owned subsidiary of the East Japan Railway Company, and on October 21, 2013 will begin offering ATM services through “VIEW ALTTE” ATMs which are operated by Viewcard and are located throughout East Japan Railway Company railway stations.

Customers of Shinsei Bank who have a Shinsei Bank *PowerFlex* cash card will now be able to withdraw money and check their account balances using their cash card at VIEW ALTTE ATMs. As with using ATMs owned by Shinsei Bank, or any other partner financial institutions, use of Viewcard ATMs will be fee free 24 hours a day.

Shinsei Bank has enlarged its ATM network by partnering with all City Banks, Japan Post Bank, and Seven Bank. With this partnership with Viewcard, Shinsei Bank will continue to work to expand its ATM network in order to further improve the convenience of *PowerFlex* for its customers.

ATMs that Will Offer Service: VIEW ALTTE ATMs operated by East Japan Railway Company

*A total of 270 VIEW ALTTE ATMs are located within the Tokyo Metropolitan area as of the end of September 2013

Service Fees: All services (cash withdrawal; balance inquiry) are free of charge regardless of time or date

Available Times: 365 days a year during operating hours of each ATM

*Operating hours can vary by ATM (Most ATMs operate from the first train to the last train of each station. ATMs located within stores will be operational during the hours of business of the store.)

*ATMs may be out of service during operating hours due to maintenance
